Position Objectives:

To ensure the effective coordination and management of fire safety monitoring to reduce the risks, prepare for and respond to from natural and human induced fire emergencies and other disasters.

Position Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist or lead in the absence of Division Commander to coordinate Fire Investigations;
- Design and maintain an effective pre-fire plan for different zones;
- Creating database of all Commercial buildings,
- Assistant Coordinator in assessing fire safety compliancy of new buildings and issue recommendations;
- Assistant coordinator to conduct fire safety inspections for public accommodations and buildings and prepare updated reports;
- Assistant coordinator to ensure follow up inspections is conducted in a timely manner;
- Assess building plans and issue fire compliancy permits to public after approval;
- Assess safe storage and installation of hazard goods including LPG gas, hazard chemicals, flammable goods etc;
- Monitors the overall building compliancy database and reports to the Division Commander
- Ensures follow up inspections are conducted in a timely manner by monitoring building compliancy database
- Designs GIS information based database in reference to relevant subjects including locations and profiles of high rise buildings, Hazard Goods buildings, water mains, hydrants, main electrical feeds, roads and streets.
- Assess relevant data and issues a risk analysis report of potential hazard based activity on a risk matrix:
- Compiles a monthly progress report and submits to division Commander;
- 24/7 Standby staff personnel for Emergency Operation on scene or where needed

- At least 3 years relevant work experience in Risk management or Building Engineering related services including but not limited to strategic planning
